

DECREE (FREE TRANSLATION)

## 4 of March 2022 nr 1-2/12

## Campaign "Supporting Ukraine"

This decree is established on the basis of §6, subsection 2, point 5 of Tallinn City Council's 18.10.2007 ordinance No 31 "Tallinn Central Library's Base Ordinance" and § 4, subsection 5, and § 5, subsection 7, of Tallinn City Council's 02.06.2016 ordinance No 19 "Usage Regulations of Tallinn Central Library".

- 1. The goal of the campaign "Supporting Ukraine" (hereafter: campaign) is to support war refugees in Estonia:
  - 1.1 enabling the use of computers to communicate with the Estonian state and their homeland, which they left behind due to the war; to keep in touch with friends and family; to search for a job and educational opportunities in Estonia;
  - 1.2 supporting the reading habits of war refugees and their children;
  - 1.3 integrating them into the Estonian society through different library services.
- 2. All war refugees who present an identification document, which confirms that they are from a country in which war is taking or recently took place, while registering as a patron of Tallinn Central Library receive their library card free of charge as part of the campaign.
- 3. All war refugees can print, copy and scan documents that are necessary for communicating with the state, finding work and educational opportunities, free of charge as part of the campaign.
- 4. Implement this decree from the 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2022.
